1. The song YESTERDAY contains actions in the past and in the present. Name 3 of each in English and in Spanish
2. The song by Ariel in Spanglish (part English – part Spanish) shows a great number of orders (imperatives) and CAN. Find 3 examples of each (3 imperatives, 3 sentences with the modal CAN) and write them in English and in Spanish
3. The song made with messages from INSTAGRAM comments contains very interesting texts, example "*I'm losing my mind*" Choose 5 of them you like and write them in English and Spanish.
4. "Wash for me" song gives us advice about what we should do; write 3 in English and Spanish; ex. Wash your hands! Lávate las manos.
5. In one of the songs we can hear the symptoms of the disease, find them (3) and write them in English and Spanish.
6. The song "CORONAVIRUS" by Tom MacDonald, is it a pessimistic or optimistic song? Why? Give reasons (2)
